Day 01

Taoyuan Night Market: A wide variety of traditional local snacks and shop for local handicrafts and tea sets.

Day 02

Formosan Aboriginal Culture Village: Earned renown for its popular theme area introducing Taiwanese aboriginal culture and for its lush forest and beautiful European Garden.

Sun Moon Lake (cruise around the lake): Is located right in the centre of Taiwan. It has an elevation of 748 meters above sea level, and is the largest natural lake in Taiwan. Next visit the **Syuanjuang Temple, Lulu Island** and **Mao Village**.

Feng Jia Night Market: Besides able to try delicious snack food, one can also get clothes at reasonable prices at this night market.

Day 03

Lugang Ancient Town: The most charming spots here is the historic alleys with ancient houses and the most special ones are the narrow-façade, deep-length patio type building.

Mo Lu Alley: Is a very narrow alley passable to each other at breast width.

Long Shan Temple: Is still well preserved despite of several renovations. The most outstanding construction is its roofs with swallow tail shaped eaves had been graded as level 2 national relic site. The main palace is dedicated to Goddess of Mercy.

Tien Hou Temple: Commonly known as Ma Zhu Temple. The lively large size Ma Zhu statue is the main feature of the temple.

Beipu Hakka Village: There is a place full with Hakka culture which is in the past century.

Xi Men Ding: A shopping paradise for young people, with a wide selection of the latest in fashion trends.

Day 4

Yehliu: An amazing array of geological formations carved out by Mother Nature, from sea-eroded trenches, beehive rocks and candlestick rocks to tofu rocks, mushroom rocks, kettle hotels and dissolved basin and the Queen's Head Rock.

Chiufen: Located up in the charming hills of Northeast Taiwan. During the Taiwanese gold rush, Chiufen was the heart of mining activities. Visitors can wonder the precipitous old street and recapture the flavour of a simple past. You can also enjoy some of the local delicacies such as Dou Kou beef noodles, Fish Ball soup and Chiufen yam ball soup.

Wu Lai Hot Spring: Enjoy a natural hot spring at here. (Naked Bath / Bring your own swim cap)

Taipei 101: Is currently the tallest building in the world. Shop in the Taipei 101 mall, or at your own expenses, ride the world's fastest elevator (1010m/min) to the 89 floor observatory, where you can enjoy the wonderful sights of Taipei, and on a clear day, even Keelung.

Wu Fen Pu: Is more on whole sale, can find many kind of fashionable clothes with reasonable price.

Day 5

National Taiwan Democracy Memorial Hall: It is the most impressive monument of the great Chinese Heralate President Chiang Kai-Shek. The bronze statue of him looks out over the city from the main building.

Marty's Shrine: Here one can witness the elaborate and graceful changing of guards's ceremony.

Pi-Siou Arts Centre: Visit one of Taiwan's famous arts centre, where you can purchase the lucky charm, Pi Siou.

Tamshui Old Street: Famous for its "iron-eggs" and well preserved building.

Fisherman's Wharf/Lovers Bridge: It is situated on the right bank of the mouth of the Tamshui River. It looks east to the Datun Mountains and southwest across the river to Guanyinshan. Along with the fishing boats and cruise ships berthed here, the wharf has a boardwalk, cafes and an expansive Harbor Park. Lover's Bridge arches like a huge white sail across the harbor, the filming site of the popular TV drama serial, "Meteor Garden".

Weige: Selling famous Taiwan pineapple tarts and assorted confectionery.

Shihlin Night Market: Is a great place for tasting local snacks such as delicious Taiwanese snacks such as the XXL crispy chicken and Oyster omelette and bargains for clothing, accessories
