Day 01:

Taoyuan Night Market: A wide variety of traditional local snacks and shop for local handicrafts and tea sets.

Day 02

High Speed Train: Experience the high speed train to Taipei city.

National Taiwan Democracy Memorial Hall: It is the most impressive monument of the great Chinese Hera-late President Chiang Kai-Shek. The bronze statue of him looks out over the city from the main building.

Yehliu: An amazing array of geological formations carved out by Mother Nature, from sea-eroded trenches, beehive rocks and candlestick rocks to tofu rocks, mushroom rocks, kettle holes and dissolved basin and the Queen's Head Rock.

Chiufen: Located up in the charming hills of Northeast Taiwan. During the Taiwanese gold rush, Chiufen was the heart of mining activities. Visitors can wander the precipitous old streets and recapture the flavour of a simpler past. You can also enjoy some of the local delicacies such as Dou Kou beef noodles, Fish Ball soup and Chiufen yam ball soup.

Hualien Amei Cultural Village: Be welcomed by the Ami Aboriginal Cultural Show with their brightly colored native outfits and unique tribal dance.

Day 03

Chihsing Tan: The only county-level scenic spot in Hualien County that is connected to Taroko Gorge, Eastern Coastline and the Eastern Rift Valley.

Local Product Centre: Where you can purchase famous Hualien product for your relatives.

Taroko National Park: Is a world-renowned majestic beauty with marble-walled gorge scenery, a narrow ravine with waterfalls, complete with a misty mountain top. Next visit the **Tunnel of Nine Turns** and **Eternal Spring Shrine**.

Marble Factory: Taiwan biggest marble factory, Kung Lung Mineral museum. You will have a chance to view unique sculptures made from marble.

Chihpen Hot Spring: Located in the Beinan Township, Taitung County, Jhihben is renowned as a hot springs resort. The water is not as hot as other hot springs and is also drinkable. (Bring your own Swim Suit and Cap).

Day 04

Heng Chun Town/Cape 7 - Aga's Home: This is the very setting where sparks of romance between the formerly feuding Aga and Tomoko were ignited and sent flying in "Cape 7" (View only - Visiting of the room is your own expense).

Mao Pi Tou: Literally known as "Cat Nose", is one of the two promontories that was formed in the southernmost Taiwan. The rock here which had been undermined and fallen into the sea, are said to resemble a crouching cat.

Fo Guang Shan: The centre of Buddhism in southern Taiwan, the large statue of Buddha can be seen in far distance and the entire mountain has been developed into a complex of temples, halls and gardens.

Mei Non Hakka Village: You will have the chance to see the traditional Hakka handicrafts, such as hand-made umbrella, bamboo handicraft etc in the village. Here you could try some Hakka traditional food, such as Ban Tiao, Ice Block and Lei Tea at your own expenses.

Leo He Night Market: Is a great place for bargains, shopping and local snacks.

Day 05

Alishan National Scenic Area/Forest Park: It is cloudy mid-elevation temperate climate with an average annual temperature 10.6°C. Here, one experience the beauty of nature, especially the grand woods and visit the famous tourist spots such as the **Sisters Pond**, the **Shouzhen Temple**, **Sacred Tree** and **Fenqihu Railway Station Museum**.

In case of Alishan can not travel, itinerary change to (Chiku Salt Field + Peng Peng Train Ride + Ying Zhang Farm + Old Fort of Anping)

Tea Centre: Here, taste the famous Alishan high mountain Oolong tea.

Senwho Resort Farm: The farm covers total area of 52 hectares. Here you can see the beautiful mountains surrounding the skyline of Chianan Plain. There are also a number of other activities all year round, such as Eco-activity, DIY coffee making, making of "Ang Gu Kueh", barbecue sweet potatoes & Free KARAOKE is also available till 11.00 pm every night.

Day 06

Sun Moon Lake (Cruise around the lake): Is located right in the centre of Taiwan. It has an elevation of 748 meters above sea level, and is the largest natural lake in Taiwan. Next visit the **Syuanjuang Temple**, **Lalu Island**, **Mao Village**, and **Wenwu Temple**.

Kuang-Hsing Paper Museum: There a paper master will show you the process of making traditional handmade paper. You can also try to DIY paper making at your own expenses.

Feng Jia Night Market: Besides able to try delicious snack food, one can also get clothes at reasonable prices at this night market.

Day 07

Miaoli Fruits Orchard: You can experience picking fresh fruits in the fruits orchard. (Own expenses).

Window of China: Was opened to the public in the 1980s. The Chinese name for the park is "xiao ren guo", which means "little Persons Country". Window on China had two distinct part- Mini Taiwan and Mini China.

Martyr's Shrine: Here one can witness the elaborate and graceful changing of guards' ceremony.

Pi-Siou Arts Centre: Visit one of Taiwan's famous arts center where you can purchase the lucky charm, Pi Siou.

Taipei 101: Is currently the tallest building in the world. Shop in the Taipei 101 mall, or at your own expenses, ride the world's fastest elevator (1010m/min) to the 89 floor observatory, where you can enjoy the wonderful sights of Taipei, and on a clear day, even Keelung.

Tamshui Old Street: Famous for its "iron-eggs" and well-preserved buildings.

Fisherman's Wharf/Lovers Bridge: It is situated on the right bank of the mouth of the Tamshui River. It looks east to the Datun Mountains and southwest across the river to Guanyinshan. Along with the fishing boats and cruise ships berthed here, the wharf has a boardwalk, cafes and and expansive Harbor Park. Lover's Bridge arches like a huge white sail across the harbor, the filming site of the popular TV drama serial, "Meteor Garden".

Weige: Selling famous Taiwan pineapple tarts and assorted confectionery.

Shihlin Night Market: Is a great place for tasting local snacks such as delicious Taiwanese snacks such as the XXL crispy chicken and Oyster omelette and bargains for clothing, accessories.
